Kate MacLeod’s Mind the Gap

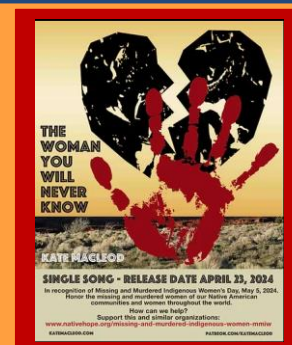
Kate MacLeod – April 20, 2024

The North Elk Coffee House is delighted to welcome Kate MacLeod back to our stage in April, just a few days before the release of her most recent project. *The Woman You Will Never Know* is scheduled for release on April 23, 2024. This moving composition is in recognition of Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women’s Day, May 5, 2024, as outlined in the insert to the right →

Another of Kate’s recent projects is a collection of Jean Ritchie songs, compiled into an album titled *Wintergrace*. Jean Ritchie was a Kentucky-born American singer/songwriter often credited with popularizing the mountain dulcimer. In the *Wintergrace* album, Kate contributes her pure, clear voice and her mastery of guitar and mountain dulcimer.

As a neo-traditional songwriter/composer/singer, Kate MacLeod puts stories to music and has a large repertoire of songs that include historic characters, miners, sailors, river runners, pioneer women, and more. Kate brings music to you through her original songs, fiddle instrumentals, and creative renditions of traditional and popular music. In addition to her Americana music, her original instrumental pieces are well suited for film soundtracks and have been used in a variety of documentaries.

When Kate joins us in April, she will be performing in a trio – “Kate MacLeod’s Mind the Gap,” pictured above. Kate is pleased to be part of the NECH 25th Anniversary Season!
